# Streamlining BPLS Program Component 1: Process Reengineering Status of Implementation 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of 2014

### BPLS Mainstreaming:

- LGUs are considered to have completed streamlining their process if the following are present and in consonance with the prescribed standard set forth by the JMC:
  - Adoption by the LGU of the unified form prescribed by the JMC and doing away with their old form.
  - ➤ Processing time for business application must not exceed 10 days for new applications and 5 days for renewals.
  - There must only be a maximum of 5 steps in the application process.
  - > The required signatories should at least be reduced to 5 or lower.
- LGUs with on-going process are those which have not yet fully complied with the standards set forth by the JMC and are currently undergoing reforms to get there.
- BPLS streamlining is not only confined to target LGUs (2010-2014), many LGUs not included in the 480 priority targets have availed of the opportunity to likewise streamline their registration process. Hence, the list prepared includes non-target LGUs to differentiate them from the 480 targets.

#### • As of 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2014 (\*cut off date for 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2014 submission is on July 15, 2014):

- o A total of 1,376 LGUs have been given training on how to streamline their BPLS
- o These consists of 137 cities and 1,239 municipalities
- 480 (100%) of which are included in the priority or target LGUs
- o 1,221 LGUs have completed streamlining their BPLS
- o 155 LGUs are still undergoing reforms
- Of the 480 priority or target LGUs, 470 (98%) LGUs have already completed their streamlining process and are currently applying it.
- o While 10 (2%) target LGUs are currently undergoing reforms in their processes.
- Aside from the target LGUs, there are also 896 non-target LGUs which received BPLS training
- o **751** of which have completed their streamlining process
- While 145 are currently undergoing reforms.
