






1) PUBLIC SECTOR CORRUPTION

Q36. How much corruption do you think there is in the public sector? [A LOT, SOME, A LITTLE, NONE]










LEVEL OF GOVERNMENT WHERE CORRUPTION HAPPENS, BY <u>AREA</u>, 2013


























EXCELLENT IN FIGHTING CORRUPTION: OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT, BY AREA, 2009 TO 2013


















"MODERATE" IN FIGHTING CORRUPTION: YOUR CITY GOVERNMENT, BY AREA, 2009 TO 2013


















"NEUTRAL" IN FIGHTING CORRUPTION: <u>SENATE</u>, BY <u>AREA</u>, 2009 TO 2013















INTRO STATEMENT: The Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) published on January 3, 2013 its Revenue Regulations (RR) No. 18- 2012, requiring all business to apply with the BIR for a new Authority to Print (ATP) Official Receipts, Sales Invoices, and Other Commercial Invoices not later than April 30 and to issue and use the new set of receipts and invoices starting July 1. On June 11, BIR Commissioner Kim Henares signed Revenue Memorandum Order 44-2013 extending the deadline for the use of old receipts, and allowing the businesses to have their new receipts and invoices printed with BIR-accredited printers.












EXTENT OF SMUGGLING IN THE PHILIPPINES, BY AREA, 2013










HOW MUCH OF A PROBLEM IS SMUGGLING FOR BUSINESSES LIKE YOURS? BY AREA, 2013
























REASONS FOR NOT REPORTING BRIBE-SOLICITATION, 2013




























FREQUENCY OF PUNISHING CORRUPT EXECUTIVES IN OWN SECTOR OF BUSINESS, BY AREA, 2013








NUMBER OF COMPANIES IN THE LINE OF BUSINESS THAT CONDUCT HONEST BUSINESS PRACTICES, 2013





Q50. In your sector of business, how many companies do you think issue receipts for all revenues?





Q51. In your sector of business, how many companies do you think keep only one set of accounts/books?







Q53. In your sector of business, how many companies do you think pay the right contributions for mandatory benefits for employees, such as SSS, PhilHealth o HDMF?









Q129. How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the City/Municipal Government's performance in promoting a good climate for business in this City/Municipality.?



Summary of Findings (1):

- Those seeing "a lot" of corruption in the public sector rose to 56% in 2013 (second-lowest since 2000), from 43% in 2012 (record-low).
- 42% say "most/almost all" companies in my sector of business give bribes to win govt. Contracts, practically the same as the record-low 41% in 2012
- Those with personal knowledge of public sector corruption in their sector of business in the last 3 months rose to 38% in 2013, from record-low 33% in 2012









Summary of Findings (2):

- Those with "extensive knowledge" of the administration's anti-corruption efforts fell slightly to 35% in 2013, from 37% in 2012.
- Those saying that the administration's steps to eradicate corruption are "somewhat/very effective" fell slightly to 73% in 2013, from 78% in 2012.
- Those saying that government "often/almost always" punishes corrupt govt. officials fell to 20% in 2013, from 27% in 2012.









Summary of Findings (3):

Ratings of sincerity of 24 gov't institutions in fighting corruption:

- 1 Excellent (+70 and above): Office of the President
- 4 Very Goods (+50 to +69): DTI, DOH, SSS, DSWD
- 4 Goods (+30 to +49): DepEd, DOLE, Supreme Court, DOJ
- 5 Moderates (+10 to +29): city govt, Ombudsman, COA, DILG,
 Sandiganbayan
- 6 Neutrals (+9 to -9): trial courts, DBM, DOTC, Comelec, DENR, Senate
- 4 Poors (-10 to -29): BIR, DPWH, PNP, House of Reps
- 1 Bad (-30 to -29): LTO
- 1 Very Bad (-50 to -69): BOC









Summary of Findings (4):

- In 2013, 53% say it is "easier" to get information for bidding on gov't contract – down from a record-high 60% in 2012
- In 2013, 88% say corruption will be reduced by passage by a strong Freedom of Information law – up from 78% in 2009
- In 2013, 77% say transaction procedures in city gov't offices are somewhat/definitely transparent – up from 73% in 2012 and 74% in 2009
- In 2013, 67% are willing to pay twice as much for a double-period of validity of a gov't license/permit – up from 63% in 2012
- Solicitations of bribes from enterprises are <u>FALLING</u>:
 - For <u>any of seven listed types of bribes</u>: 2013 44% (new all-time low) vs 2012 50%, 2009 60%.









Summary of Findings (5):

The fight against private sector corruption is generally favorable:

- Citations of private sector corruption being "a lot" is 9% in 2013, more or less flat since 2003
- Citations that "most/almost all" companies in their sector of business give bribes to win private sector contracts fell from 27% in 2012 to 23% in 2013, but still higher than all in 2006-2009
- Citations that corrupt executives in their sector of business are "often/almost always" punished fell from record-high 60% in 2012 to 55% in 2013
- Enterprises with clear rules on giving gifts to government officials are 48% in both 2013 and 2012









Summary of Findings (6):

- Citations that "almost all" companies in my line of business conduct honest business practices are FLAT
- The business climate is GOOD
 - Satisfaction that the <u>national government</u> is promoting a good climate reached new record- high 70% in 2013, versus 69% in 2012
 - Satisfaction that the <u>city government</u> is promoting a good climate reached new record -high 67% in 2013, versus 64% in 2012.
 - Business expectations for the next two years are excellent/good – reached new record- high 76% in 2013, versus 74% in 2012.
